FEATURES

(A) Light Bubbles

With the fretboard illuminated by light bubbles, the gTar can show you where to put your fingers.

(B) Connections

The power button and all external connections are located on the bottom side of the gTar. Here, you can connect USB headphones or the included SmartPick.



Left to Right:

- Smart Pick
- USB
- Power
- Earphones/AUX

(c) iPhone® Dock

This enables your phone to power the entire gTar experience. When you run the gTar app for the first time make sure the iPhone is docked into the gTar (see Docking).


Download the gTar app for iPhone available for free in the App Store (See back to learn more about the app).

(E) Charging

To charge the gTar, simply insert the included USB cable into the gTar's USB port and plug the opposite end into the included power brick or any standard USB dock.

- Green Charged
- Orange Charging
- Blinking Red Battery Drained (power off and plug in)





DOCKING

Don't forget to install the app first!



Place the iPhone into the dock, connector-end first.



While pulling back the clasp, gently slide the phone into the dock. Once flat and flush, you should feel the clasp click into place.



To remove the iPhone, push the button all the way down and release; the top of the iPhone should pop up out of the dock so you can remove it entirely.

GETTING STARTED

- Pick up the gTar. Put the guitar strap (included) over your shoulder (see moustached diagram).
- On the gTar app, press

 PLAY and choose a song.

PLAY MODE

DIFFICULTY SETTINGS



Easy: Just play the strings.



Medium: Play the strings and frets. The wrong notes won't play.



Hard: Like Medium but every note will play, even the incorrect ones.

PLAYING THE STRINGS



B Single Note:

Press down and then pluck the string.



FREE PLAY

VI/ LIGHTS

Control the shape, color, and loop effects of the light bubbles in the Lights panel. Use the grid and sliders (a) to control the lighting



effects along the fretboard with your finger as the guide. The All button (b) fills the fretboard with the selected color and the Clear button (c) will turn off all of the active light bubbles.

EFFECTS

The Effects panel lets you add ambience, distortion, and other sound modifiers. Each effect can be turned on and off by tapping the



Power button (d), which will light up when activated. To manipulate effects, first select the effect name from the menu so that it lights up and then use the expression pad (e) to change the effect settings.

INSTRUMENTS

The app includes a range of instruments to enhance your playing experience and expand the capabilities of the gTar. To change



the instrument, simply tap once on the name of the instrument you wish to use. The selection will blink for a few moments while the instrument loads; when the blinking has finished, you can begin playing the instrument.
